

Existing Home Rebates

Diverse Power offers incentives to member consumers upgrading their existing water heating and/or heating and cooling systems to more energy efficient equipment. In order to qualify for these incentives, please complete the following information and return it along with a paid receipt for the installed equipment to our office. Once this information is received, your rebate will be processed as a credit on your electric account.

- Electric heat pump replacing existing heat pump, electric heat, or wood heater.
- Electric heat pump replacing a gas furnace.
- Dual fuel heat pump replacing any existing system.
- Geothermal heat pump replacing any existing system.
- Electric water heater replacing existing water heater.
- Electric water heater replacing a gas water heater.

1. All rebate requests must be submitted for installations that have been complete for no more three months; this means that all HVAC and water heating equipment is installed in its final condition. If a job has been complete for more than three months, it will not be eligible for rebates.
2. Tankless water heaters are not eligible for rebates.
3. Heat pumps and water heaters must be new equipment that has never been previously used.
4. Heat pump must be connected to whole house air-tight ductwork.

Existing Home Improvement Rebates

Heat Pumps:

Electric to electric change out: ≤ 14 SEER \$100; ≥ 15 SEER \$200

Electric heat pump replacing existing heat pump, electric resistance heat or wood heat.

Electric replacing gas heat: ≤ 14 SEER \$300; ≥ 15 SEER \$400

Electric heat pump replacing natural gas, propane gas or oil heat as the primary heating system.

Dual fuel heat pump: ≤ 14 SEER \$250; ≥ 15 SEER \$300

Dual fuel heat pump replacing electric heat pump, electric resistance heat, wood heat, natural gas heat, propane gas heat or oil heat, as the primary heating system.

Geothermal heat pump \$250/Ton

A certified geothermal dealer must do geothermal system replacing any type of system and installation.

Water Heaters:

Electric water heater must be at least 30-gallon capacity and have dual heating elements.

Electric to electric change out \$75 per unit; \$150 for Marathon or GE Hybrid

Electric water heater replacing existing electric water heater.

Electric replacing gas \$300 per unit; \$500 for Marathon or GE Hybrid

Electric water heater replacing gas water heater.

Waste Heat Recovery Unit \$250 per house

Waste heat recovery system installed on an existing electric water heater. Only one rebate per home is permitted, even if there are multiple systems installed.

Thermostats:

Programmable thermostat with adaptive recovery \$25

Insulation:

Bring attic insulation up to R-38 level/Foam attic \$300/\$500

Total Leakage Reduction (Ducts/House Combined):

Reduce leakage by $\geq 20\%$ \$ 600

Reduce leakage by $\geq 25\%$ \$ 800

Reduce leakage by $\geq 30\%$ \$1,000

Blower door and duct leakage tests must be performed and results forwarded to Diverse Power Inc. prior to any measures or improvements being considered for reimbursement. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from whole house improvement rebates.
