New Construction Rebates

Rebates are paid on homes that meet or exceed national, state and local building and energy codes. Any variance of the guidelines from these codes should be brought to the attention of Diverse Power. It is the responsibility of the builder/homeowner to interpret the code for the county in which the home is being built.

Air Source Heat Pump \$50/ton (\$200 max)

This rebate amount is per system, and can be combined with rebates for other systems installed, such as dual fuel heat pumps, geothermal heat pumps, electric water heaters and/or waste heat recovery systems. An electric water heater is required in any new home for it to be eligible for heat pump rebates.

Geothermal Heat Pump \$350/Ton

This rebate amount is per ton, and can be combined with rebates for other systems installed, such as an all-electric heat pump or waste heat recovery system. The unit must be installed by a certified contractor. An electric water heater is required.

Electric Water Heater \$100/Unit

Electric water heater must be at least <u>40-gallon or higher capacity</u> and have dual heating elements.

NIMA 14-50 or 14-30 Outlet installed \$50.00 per outlet

Customer must install a dedicated outlet for a Level II charger for an EV. Rebate will be based on number of chargers/outlets customer has verified.

NOTES:

- 1. Underground electric service is available to all new consumers at a cost to be determined.
- Rebate request must be submitted for houses that have been complete for no more than three months; this means that the house has gone from temporary power to permanent power and all HVAC and water-heating equipment is installed in its final condition. If a house has been complete for more than three months, it will not be eligible for rebates. Rebates must be applied for – they are not automatically paid.
- 3. Rebates are paid directly to the builder of the home unless otherwise agreed upon by the builder and homeowner.
- 4. Tankless water heaters are not eligible for rebate.
- 5. Mini-split systems ducted/ductless are eligible.
- 6. Rebate is per unit.
